Track the progress of graduating Webelos to ensure that all youth transfer applications and appropriate registration fees are being collected.  Insure that all applications are turned in to the District Executive, Scout Office, or at the District Report meeting.  Work with unit commissioners to follow up with Webelos Scouts who have not joined a troop.  Report progress to the District Membership Chair. |
